Exams

There will be four (4) exams for this course, three (3) regular exams and the final exam. The first three exams will be worth 150 points each and the final exam will be worth 250 points.

Each exam will cover all material presented in class and course assignments, as well as any information covered in the assigned chapters of the textbook. The first three exams will cover specific chapters covered in class and the fourth exam will be the final exam.

The fourth exam will cover the chapters covered in class after exam number three **AND** cumulative questions from the information covered on the first three exams. In other words, the fourth exam will be the final exam, and part of the final exam will be cumulative. Approximately 60% of the fourth exam will cover material from the last chapters covered in class and 40% of the final exam will cover information from the semester as a whole.

Exam Schedule

Exams will be taken outside of class, on-line using the OIS program UTest. Exact dates of the exams will be determined by the speed that we progress through the chapters that are part of each exam. As much advanced notice as possible will be given before any exam.

Final Exam

The final exam will be given on-line, and will be due at the time the University has scheduled for your classes day and time. The final exam is the fourth of the four exams for this class.
